A Breakdown of the Share Sizes

NEW! Spring Greens Share \$150: Nothing but salad and a variety of fixings for that Spring greens craving. Romaine, spinach, arugula, salad greens, baby mixed greens, head lettuce, radishes, scallions, endive, escarole, watercress. 4 weeks (mid-May till mid-June) 1/2 bushel or 5/9ths box.

Standard Share \$520: A healthy dose of vegetables each week with some herbs and fruit. Perfect for small families or couples, 1/2 bushel or 5/9 box. 20 weeks.

Double Share \$800: A double dose of vegetables each week with some herbs and fruits, ideal for families and veggie lovers or to split with another household, 1 bushel or 1 1/9 box. 20 weeks.

Every Other Week (EOW) \$260: Same size and variety of garden goodies as the standard share but delivered every other week. A great fit for couples and individuals, 1/2 bushel or 5/9 box. 10 weeks.

Flower Share \$120: Weekly during the flowering season we will bring a big, beautiful bouquet of unique and standard cut flowers to brighten your home. (Only 5 spaces available.) 10 weeks. Start date TBA, weather pending.

Winter Storage Share \$110: These veggies will store well into winter. Winter squash, onions, potatoes, garlic, Brussels sprouts, beets, pie pumpkin, diakon radish, spinach and more! Deliveries go out several days before Thanksgiving. 2 bushels. Some families order two shares.
